MPL Rights Verification

There are two easy ways to verify license coverage



Use the new complimentary Motion Picture License (MPL) tool to verify movie coverage by going to https://www.copyright.com/landing/mpl-lookup/.

Type in the name of the movie you are looking for, use the dropdown menu to select your language, and click 'Submit'. A green check mark indicates that the film is covered by the license.




Click View Details for a basic description of the film along with primary cast members.

While extensive, the database does not include all movie titles covered by the license or television shows. An alternative way to verify rights is using IMDb (Internet Movie Database).

Enter the title in the search field. Select the correct title, click the More tab located above the movie rating, then click Company Credits to view information about the film or television show production companies and distributors.



Cross reference the producer or distributor against <u>CCC's List of MPL Participating Theatrical Distributors & Producers</u> to verify coverage.
