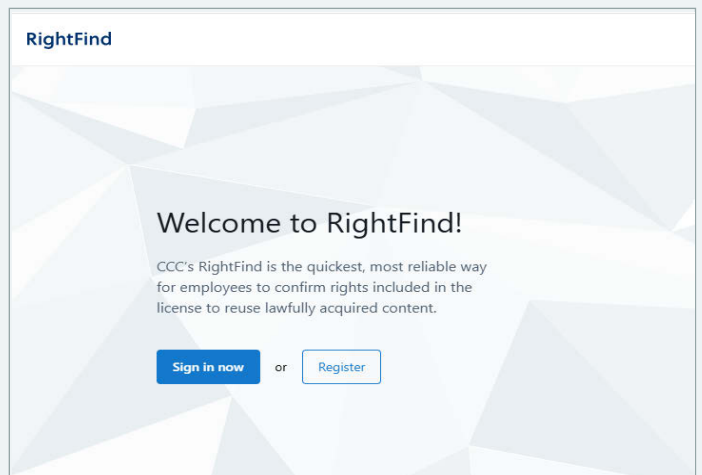
## Verifying License Coverage with RightFind® Advisor

## Accessing RightFind Advisor

If you are on a computer outside of your company's network, you must log in. If you are a new user, register your account with a company approved domain (this should be your professional email).
