The solution includes a content and search and discovery tool, a curated collection of high-quality works, and a broad set of rights to use excerpts of high-quality fiction and non-fiction books, magazines, newspapers, and web content from leading publishers, in curriculum and instruction.

- Online tools and resources, including a template; list of participating publishers and usage reporting
- Access to the Content Discovery Portal where you can search for content by various criteria such as Lexile score, grade level, subject, length, genre, and more for use in curriculum, lessons, and online platforms.
- Access to the Publisher Gateway for any works that you are unable to find in the portal. Here you will find information about publishers who offer curriculum users free access to their content for search and discovery purposes



Navigating the Simple Search Home Page

To access the title coverage verification tool in RightFind Curriculum, open your web browser and type in the URL string provided by CCC. If you need the link please email <u>aclcisupport@</u> <u>copyright.com</u>. Once the tool is launched, the simple search home page will automatically display.



On this page, you can search for titles in a number of ways:

• Search by publication name, standard number - either ISSN or ISBN, or Author

Access Content

Click on the Access Content button located in the top right of the RightFind Curriculum home page to log in to the Content Discovery Portal to search for and identify content. You can also access the Publisher Gateway where you can view a list of publishers that have agreed to provide free access to their content for users to aid in the search and discovery of content covered under by RightFind Curriculum.

Understanding Search Options

There are several different ways to initiate a search within RightFind Curriculum to verify title coverage. You can search by publication name, ISBN/ISSN number or Author. Below are some details about each of these search options.

Search by Publication Name

When the publication name is known, simply enter it in the search box, click the search icon, and results will be generated. Search for a standard number or Author in the same manner. You can search for multiple publication names using the "and" or "or" qualifier between the publication names. This can also be done in "Advanced Search."



Helpful Tip: Publication Search

Having trouble with a publication search? Searching for a publication name is easy. Just be sure to use the title of the work to complete the search – not a chapter name or an article title.



Search by Standard Numbers

If the ISSN of a journal or the ISBN of a book is known, simply enter the number (with or without dashes) e.g., 978-0-470-71973-2 or 9780470719732, into the search box and click the search icon. Using a single standard number produces results for a single book or journal. Book standard numbers can be 10 or 13 digits long while journals and newspapers are usually eight digits long.



Helpful Tip: Finding Standard Numbers

Need to find the standard number of a publication?

- An **ISBN** is printed on the lower portion of the back cover of a book above the bar code as well as on the copyright page.
- An **ISSN on a print publication** is generally displayed on the upper right corner of the journal cover or on the pages where editorial information is displayed. If the publication is online, the ISSN may be found on the homepage or on the main menu.
- An ISSN in electronic media can be found on the homepage of the publication.



Advanced Search

The Advanced Search feature allows you to search the RightFind Curriculum database in a more granular fashion.

The Anatomy of a Results Page (Simple Search)

Below is a breakdown of the standard components of a simple search.



Depending on your version of RightFind Curriculum, below are the various types of use you can get:

- Reuse in K-12 Curriculum & Instruction
- Reuse in a K-12 Platform
- Reuse in a K-12 Product
- Reuse in a Higher Education Product



Associated with these types of use, you will see one of four symbols:

- ✓ A green checkmark symbol indicates you can use the content under the terms of the Annual Copyright License for Curriculum & Instruction.
- ① A green exclamation point symbol indicates the title may be used, but the publisher has additional terms associated with the use of that particular work. In order to proceed, you must click the **TERMS** link to the right and abide by the terms therein.
- ③ An orange question mark symbol means the work is not covered for use by RightFind Curriculum. In most cases, the work is published by a participating publisher, but has not been pre-authorized for use under the license. To request coverage, select the **Request coverage** link to reveal a pop-up form prepopulated with the metadata from the work selected. Simply complete the required fields labeled with an asterisk to request coverage. There is also an optional Additional comments box to include any additional information or comments. The more information provided, the better chance the publisher of the title will approve its use under the license. Selecting the **Submit** button will notify CCC that the work has been requested for use in curriculum and versus & instructional materials. In addition, you will see the word **Region**, directly under the symbol indicating whether you can use the content in curriculum and instruction anywhere in the world, i.e., Worldwide, or only in the United States.



Understanding Each Section of the Search Results Pages

Item Metadata

Each title that appears in the results set is displayed with important metadata needed for usage and provides essential information to properly verify the work. The data supplied includes the material type (e.g., book, journal, newspaper, etc.), the standard number, the publication date, the author(s) and the publisher of the title.



Titles with Pre-Authorization

Authorization to use a portion of a work in curriculum and instructional materials is clearly displayed in the "How can I use this copyrighted content?" section of the results page. The indicates the title may be used in curriculum and instructional materials under the terms of the RightFind Curriculum agreement.

Once selected, the ✓ Reuse in K-12 Curriculum & Instruction link expands to provide more detail about the reuse rights authorized under RightFind Curriculum.

The ① indicates the title may be used, but the publisher has additional terms associated with the use of that particular work. In order to proceed, you must click the **TERMS** link to the right and abide by the terms therein.

Titles without Pre-Authorization

Occasionally titles are displayed with the 😢 symbol. This means the work is not covered for use under RightFind Curriculum. In most cases, the work is published by a participating publisher but has not been pre-authorized for use under the license.



Request Coverage

To request coverage to use an article/excerpt, select the Request coverage link to reveal a pop-up form prepopulated with the metadata from the work selected.

Usage Reporting Requirement
